Prospective New Directors Information Sheet

General Background (See Co-Operative Rules for more information)

- 1. Directors are elected at annual general meetings (AGMs).
- 2. The Board has 7 Directors.
- 3. Directors must be over the age of 18.
- 4. Retiring Directors are eligible for re-election without nomination.
- 5. Any election of directors is conducted by secret ballot and in such a proper manner as the board directs.
- 6. The Board meets monthly (but not less than every 3 months).
- 7. Director remuneration is approved at AGMs.
- 8. The Chairperson of the Board is to be elected by the Board.

Election Process

- 9. In accordance with Co-Operative rules, four directors are resigning at the AGM but have nominated for re-election (further details in the AGM agenda contained in the Annual Report sent to members on 3 Nov 22).
- 10. People nominating for the position of director:
 - a. Are required to have a Director Number issued by the Australian Business Registry Services.
 - b. Are to provide a resume of their qualifications for circulation to Co-Operative members prior to the AGM which will support the ballot for directors' process.
 - c. Are advised to be familiar with the Mullumbimby Rural Co-operative Society Limited's Rules (particularly the Board of directors' section) adopted Nov 21 (hard copies available at the Co-Operative).
